

MAINTAINING FELT

VACUUMING & BRUSHING

While less attractive to dust than other fibers, wool will still pick up airborne debris over time. That is why every once in a while Brand Felt Wool Felt should be vacuumed or gently brushed by hand.

As you clean, you may notice some shedding of fibers. Fear not: it is normal even for high-density felt to have loosened fibers at the beginning. Suck them up with a vacuum and the shedding will take care of itself.

SPOT CLEANING

Wool fibers have a naturally-occurring waxy coating that gives them a temporary stain shield. This means you have more time to blot up liquid spills before they can leave a nasty stain. We recommend soaking up any liquid spills with a dry cloth as soon as possible.

If you are dealing with a soiled spot, you can spot clean it with warm water or a mild, dry cleaning solvent.

Remember to rub gently, as aggressive rubbing could alter the surface of the felt. If you are able to remove the felt, consider seeking the professional touch of a dry cleaning company. Of course, we recommend choosing a company familiar with the care of wool felt.

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
